On completion of the training course, you will be issued with a Substation & Rescue Board Safety Training Certificate.

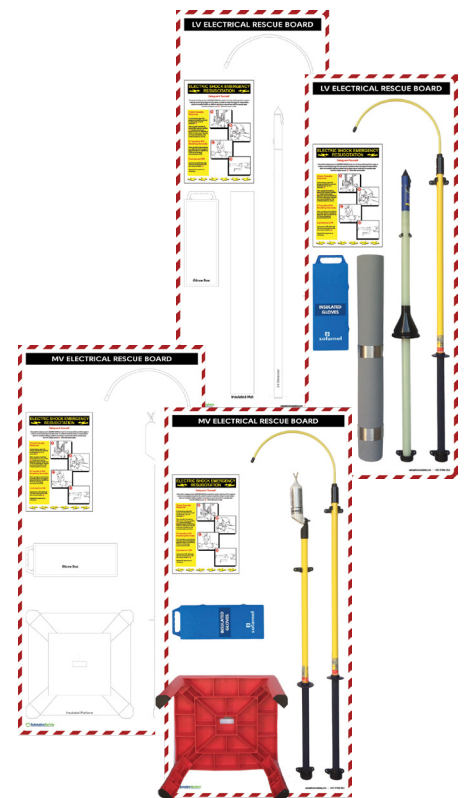

This “hands on” training includes how to test for loss of voltage, proving your voltage detector is working, how to confirm your test equipment is in date, understanding the different symbols on the insulated poles and how to check your insulated gloves. Where required, training can also incorporate CPR training and the correct use of defibrillators.
